Anything above the 1,000/3,000 sq. ft maximum will be paid at \$2.00 per sq. ft., unless an exception has been requested in writing prior to commencement of the project. Turf removal sites installing synthetic turf are also eligible to receive \$1.50 per sq. ft of synthetic turf installed within the turf removal project area, up to a maximum of 1,000 sq ft. installed per residential site and 3,000 sq. ft. installed per commercial site. Sites wishing to

		receive synthetic turf rebate funding above the 1,000/3,000 sq. ft. maximum will need to request an exception in writing prior to the commencement of the project. Exceptions will be considered on a case-by case basis.
